Overview

Does Samoa have a solar farm?

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and Sun Pacific Energy Ltd (SPEL) have signed a US\$2.8 million (approximately AU\$4.3 million) loan to expand renewable energy generation in Samoa. The financing will upgrade and expand SPEL's Upolu Solar Farm—Samoa's first independent power producer (IPP)—by installing high-efficiency solar panels.

Why is Samoa launching a solar power project?

The project is part of Samoa's broader commitment to combat climate change and achieve energy independence. The new solar power project, developed with funding from international development partners including the Asian Development Bank (ADB), is expected to stabilise energy costs and increase energy security.

How will Samoa's New solar farm work?

The financing will upgrade and expand SPEL's Upolu Solar Farm—Samoa's first independent power producer (IPP)—by installing high-efficiency solar panels. The expansion is expected to deliver 9.6 gigawatt-hours of clean energy annually and cut carbon dioxide emissions by a further 1,944 tonnes.

How much electricity does Samoa generate?

016, now stands at 11MW. These included Sun Pacific Energy (2MW), Green Power Samoa at Faleata Racecourse (4MW) and Solar for Samoa (5MW). With the introduction of the 550kW wind turbine in 2014, Samoa have since generated 488MWh of electricity with 201

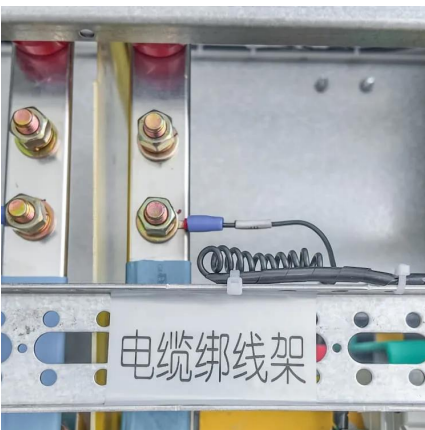
