Is Burkina Faso importing energy from Cote d'Ivoire?

Energy needs in Burkina Faso are growing at a 13% annualized rate, and the country is currently importing energy from Cote d'Ivoire. The plant was built by Cegelec, and funded by donations from the European Union and France's development agency, permitting \$0.084 per kilowatt-hour, which is considerable cheaper than thermal production.

Does Burkina Faso have an informal economy?

In Burkina Faso, however, the informal sector is an important sector of the economy. A sizable part of the Burkinabe population earns a living in the informal economy, especially in agriculture and artisanal mining sectors. Artisanal mining alone is estimated to employ one million to 1.3 million people directly.

How much money does Burkina Faso export to the United States?

The United States exported US\$ 273.61 million worth of goods, whereas Burkina Faso exported to the United States US\$ 9.5 million in goods. The top U.S. imports category for 2020 was Agricultural Products (cotton and cashew).

Which sector employs the most Burkina Faso workers?

Some mining sector experts estimate mining sector employment—industrial and artisanal—to surpass that of agriculture, the sector that historically has employed the most Burkinabe. In 2021, Burkina Faso was Africa's fourth largest gold producer after South Africa, Ghana, and Mali.
