Overview

How has the Zambian telecom sector changed over the last decade?

The Zambian telecom sector has seen positive and significant development over the last decade with reforms in 1994 which opening the Zambian telecom market to new entrants. One of the significant measures includes the establishment of national ICT policy for regulating the telecom sector of Zambia.

How Zambia is investing in the telecom sector?

Zambia has witnessed increased investment in the telecom sector. The country is still looking for a fourth major mobile service provider for covering the entire country. Zambia has also launched Public Private Partnerships (PPPS) to accelerate investment in telecom sector by local and international investors.

What telecommunications are available in Zambia?

Telecommunications in Zambia includes radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. The state-owned Zambia National Broadcasting Corporation (ZNBC) operates three radio networks. Roughly two dozen private radio stations are operating. Relays of at least two international broadcasters are accessible in Lusaka and Kitwe.

When did mobile telephony start in Zambia?

The Zambian government began the process of liberalization telephony in 1991 when the telecom sector was dominated by ZAMTEL, the state owned company. This resulted in significant developments in mobile telephony in Zambia.

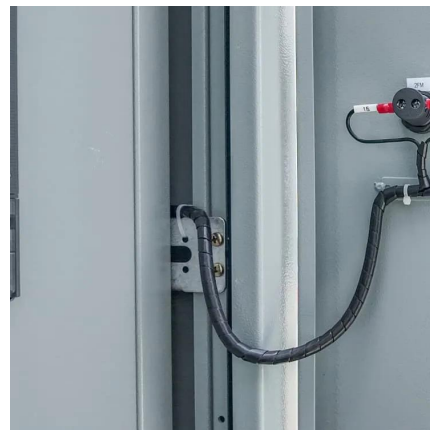
